Any teacher interested in applying for a grant must use the Pentucket Arts Foundation **Grants Request Form** (included below and at <https://www.pentucketarts.org>). Grants may only be submitted by staff from the six schools in our district: Elmer S. Bagnall School, John C. Page School, Frederick N. Sweetsir School, Helen R. Donaghue School, Pentucket Regional Middle School, and Pentucket Regional High School.

The application deadline is **November 1st**. All requests will be presented to the Board of Directors at its next scheduled meeting. Awards will be announced shortly afterwards. The total distribution for this cycle is **\$2,500**.

The Arts Foundation would like to see our funds used to enrich the greatest number of students. We would also prefer, when possible, to appropriate funds for requests that will enrich students for many years to come.
