PURPOSE: This grant is designed to give students a chance to take their love of a particular fine or performing arts form to a new level. It encompasses all visuals arts, theatre, music (both instrumental and vocal) and dance/movement. The focus is to nurture your talent and also to share that passion with others. Proposals to bring a visiting artist to the district to benefit multiple students are also welcome.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to Pentucket students – or groups of students – in grades 7 - 11.

AWARD AMOUNT: up to \$2,500.

THE PROCESS:

PART 1: THE APPLICATION - Research an artistic opportunity you would like to experience. Speak with teachers in the arts department for possibilities. Fill out the attached application form as completely as possible and return to address below by March 15th.

PART 2: THE INTERVIEW - The Pentucket Arts Foundation Board of Directors will review your application and if you are being considered for funding you will be contacted to schedule a brief interview with the Board.

PART 3: COMMUNITY CONNECTION - Share something of what you learn from your artistic opportunity with your peers and/or the Pentucket community. <u>This must be a free offering for the community so please make sure to include any anticipated costs in your total grant request.</u> A Pentucket Arts teacher must sign off on your concept. (See last page for specific examples)
